Family Camps

Session 1: May 22-25

(Available to brand new camp families)

Held over Memorial Day Weekend. This session is reserved for families of a child with cancer, ages 6-16, who has never attended Happiness Is Camping.

(Available to all current camp families)

Open to ALL families of a child with cancer, ages 6-16. Participate in daily activities such as archery, high ropes, and arts and crafts, swim in the pool, play a few of our night activities, and compete in Color Wars!

Counselor and Mentorship Program

Open to all 16-year-old campers and siblings and will be held for FOUR sessions during Sessions 2-5 of Summer Camp. CAMPers will participate in STEM workshops, prepare for college, learn basic life skills such as cooking and balancing a checkbook, meet with guest speakers, and will serve as Counselors-In-Training and gain work experience.

Any child with cancer, in treatment or remission, ages 6 to 16 years old is welcome to attend.

All that is required is that the child's personal physician determines the child is well enough to attend. All medical care, food, and activities are included.
